Please describe the difference between creating a website using an Application such as Adobe Dreamweaver and a Content Management System such as WordPress.



WordPress is much more of a template for website design with tools such as automatic link embedding and templates to very easily import files and text instantly into the site format, whereas a more coding and hands-on method for web design is in line with Adobe Dreamweaver and similar applications which allows much more customization and in depth tweaking.
